Capital Structure . The balance sheet can tell you about the capital structure of the firm, which is the mix of debt and equity a firm holds, and can reveal the extent to which a firm relies on outside sources for financing. It's usually expressed as a debt-to-equity ratio, which you can calculate if you divide the liabilities on the balance sheet by the owners' equity.
