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Haiku is a poem of ancient Japanese origin. It contains 17 syllables in 3 lines of 5-7-5. Haiku poems are typically about nature and usually about a specific season. It is easy to feel a sense of perfection when viewing a perfectly formed Haiku.

If you're using two or more poems by the same author, then just using the author's last name isn't a clear enough indication for the in-text citation for which poem you're discussing or quoting from. In this case, put the author's last name, a comma, the poem title (or a shortened version) in quotes, a space, and then the line numbers from the poem.

If you want to incorporate a little more complexity into an alternating rhyme scheme, then try structuring your poem in ballade form. This features 2 sets of 4 alternating rhymes divided by 1 extra line that rhymes with the second line. Then, a third set of 4 alternating rhymes that features the same rhymes as the second set follows.
