If there is a title and subtitle, the two should be on different lines, separated by a colon. Assemble your paper in the following order: Cover/Title page; Body of the paper; Appendix (if needed) Endnotes (if using endnote style) Bibliography; Title/Cover Page Center the title of your page around half-way down.
