The clinical cure rate at 5-9 days after completion of therapy was also higher in the trimethoprim-sulfamethoxazole-susceptible group (88% of 333 women) than in the trimethoprim-sulfamethoxazole-resistant group (54% of 151 women; $P < .001$). The clinical and microbiological differences remained significant at the 28-42-day follow-up visit.
