At the beginning and end of each scale, finger numbers indicated in superscript or subscript should be used instead of finger numbers immediately following or preceding them. For example, the C scale begins with a 5 instead of a 1 in the left hand, and it ends with a 5 instead of a 1 in the right hand.

Scale and Arpeggio Fingering Sheet - Cerebroom

Fingering is listed for two octaves ascending and descending for arpeggios. Practice scales and arpeggios slowly and increase the tempo as you become more comfortable with the fingerings. A good tempo to shoot for on scales is half note = 88, with the eighth note being the common denominator.
